Transmission Line Relocation Agreement (TLRAs) – Customer-driven projects which require alterations to transmission plant; typically relocation of one or more transmission wood poles.

Distribution requests – Alterations to transmission plant driven by customer or internal changes to distribution plant within transmission right-of-way.

Civil Protective Program – Mitigation of geotechnical hazards to transmission structures, typically erosion protection with riprap or slope stabilization measures.

The successful candidate must be able to apply principles of professional project management to align with PCM's work program management and governance models; including employing PCM's processes and workflow templates to pre- screen projects in collaboration with other internal stakeholders including environment, indigenous relations, properties and AIM; PCM share-point sites, document archiving, STARR updates and project completion reports (PCR).

Collaborate with initiators to prepare budget and schedule estimates for customer and internal projects, and with overhead and underground Transmission, electrical, civil and geotechnical teams to complete designs. Leverage Field Operations, Construction Services, Construction Management, and/or external contractors to implement projects.
